#### **Registration Process**

All students wishing to take a night school course:



- Must FULLY complete the <u>registration request</u> form or the QR Code
- Registration requests will be forwarded to their Guidance Counsellor for review and approval (current Secondary Day School Students only)
- Registration requests will be processed only after Guidance Counsellor approval is received (current Secondary Day School Students only)
- February 13, 2025 @ 12:00 noon: Deadline for all approved registration forms

#### **Cancellation of Courses**

- Courses run pending enrolment
- Students will receive calls/emails only if the course has been cancelled
- Students are strongly advised to check cancellation/availability lists posted in Guidance areas

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ**

Delivery of Courses: Courses will be delivered in person or online synchronous.

Online Synchronous Courses: Students who have selected the \*\*ONLINE SYNCHRONOUS course option are expected to have device cameras "turned-on" to enhance the overall learning experience. More information will be provided to these students a <u>couple of days prior</u> to the start of class

Attendance: Regular attendance is crucial for success in all Night School credit programs. Attendance and punctuality are compulsory. Students must participate on the first day of Night School or will be withdrawn from the course. Students will be demitted after 3 (three) consecutive absences. Students may be demitted following a contravention of the Catholic Code of Conduct.

**Textbooks:** Textbook information will be provided to students by the teacher on the first night of classes.

Reports: An interim report will be issued mid-way through the course. All students MUST write or complete their FINAL Assessment.

<u>Safe Schools:</u> The DPCDSB Safe Schools Policy is posted at <a href="http://www.dpcdsb.org">http://www.dpcdsb.org</a> follow the link to Safe Schools. Students whose behaviour impacts the safety or learning of other students will be withdrawn.

Registration Criteria for Day Students: The student has the required prerequisite and the Principal/Designate has approved the application. Students must be at least 16 years of age and have completed grade 10.

<u>Dress Code:</u> Students must dress appropriately for the school environment. A policy statement regarding expectations will be shared the first evening of credit Night School by the school administration.

International Fee-Paying Students: Students on a Visa Permit must contact the Adult and Continuing Education office at 905-362-0701 EXT. 50016 for further directions prior to applying through their Guidance office. Letters of authorization and fees must be obtained prior to Night School commencing.

**Special Education:** Students who may require accommodations are advised to consult with their Guidance Counsellor regarding Night School expectations and recommendations.

First Night: Students should save a copy of their registration once submitted.
